Brian was an excellent running back. He played football for the sheer love of the game. He was committed to football during the off-season, competed in three sports and conditioned during the summer. During his junior year he incurred a severe knee injury. His dedication and desire drove him to rehabilitate his knee and regain a starting position. He came back his senior year to play in every game.

He was an excellent student and a leader in the school community. Brian was tragically killed his freshman year in college. Through the efforts of his parents and the Touchdown Club, there is a \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a senior football player who:

- Is an Armstrong Football Player with the commitment and dedication to the sport because he “loves” the game.
- Has also played with such “Gusto” he was an inspiration to his teammates.
- Has at least a “C” average and is passing all his classes.
- Has “given back” to Armstrong by leadership, and /or volunteers in some capacity.
- Has to be attending college, but does not have to play football there. (the money is sent directly to the college: the winner of the scholarship will need to inform Armstrong’s bookkeeper with the school to be attended, social security number, and student number if available)
